- 1 - Train starts at Kirkby Stephen, having arrived from Carlisle at 07 17
- 2 - Fast service, does **NOT** call at Horton, Ribbleshead, Dent, Garsdale, Langwathby, Lazonby or Armathwaite.
- 3 - Until 17 October. 'Dalesrail' services to/from Blackpool North, does **NOT** call at Skipton, Keighley, Bingley, Shipley or Leeds.
- 4 - Until 5 September. 'Dalesrail' services to/from Preston, does **NOT** call at Skipton, Keighley, Bingley, Shipley or Leeds.
- 5 - Line **CLOSED** for engineering work Sundays 24 & 31 October & 7 November, buses replace trains - a special timetable will operate.

Getting to the station:

Kirkby Stephen station is 1½ miles west of Kirkby Stephen, on the main A685 Tebay road.

ON FOOT From Kirkby Stephen town there is a waymarked public footpath across fields (muddy when wet), walking time around 30 minutes.

BY BIKE There are no official cycle storage facilities at the station.

BY BUS There are regular buses linking the station with the town centre on Mondays to Saturdays, but none on Sundays.

Plusbus (01768 341 328), serving the town and surrounding villages from the bus stop in the station car park.

Arrivals from the town: Mondays to Fridays 0716, 1018, 1253, 1506 (no 1506 on Tuesdays or Thursdays); Saturdays 0838, 1016.

Departures to the town: Mondays to Fridays 0718, 1038, 1254, 1508 (no 1508 on Tuesdays or Thursdays); Saturdays 0850, 1038.

Cumbria Classic Coaches (01539 623 254). Heritage buses from the bus stop in the station car park.

Tuesdays only, to 26 October only: Ravenstonedale - Kirkby Stephen station at 1040 - town - Hawes; Hawes - Kirkby Stephen town - station at 1615 - Ravenstonedale. Extends from Hawes to Ribbleshead Viaduct 6 July - 26 October.

Wednesdays only: Ravenstonedale - Kirkby Stephen station at 1035 - town - Barnard Castle; Barnard Castle - Kirkby Stephen town - station at 1622 (1522 from 3 November) - Ravenstonedale.

Kirkby Lonsdale Coaches, service 564 linking the town and station with Kendal calls at the bus stop on the main road by the station entrance.

Arrivals from the town: Mondays to Saturdays 0710 (no 0710 on Saturdays), 0945, 1240, 1515, 1805.

Departures to the town: Mondays to Saturdays 0927, 1157, 1500, 1727. (01524 733 831 - Kirkby Lonsdale Coaches).

BY CAR The station is 5 minutes from the town centre, or 20 minutes from Junction 38 on the M6. There is ample free parking.

Fares: One third off adult full fares for railcard holders: 16 - 25, Senior, Family & Friends or Dales (all local residents & FoSCL members eligible). Children aged 5 - 15 half price.
